**Be a Hedgehog Friendly Campus advocate.** Take part in our Hogfriendly events, and support the campaign by sharing information on socials.



**Check your bonfires.** When it comes to bonfire night, make sure you check for prickly friends before the big night if you're taking part.



**Set up or join a litter pick!** Make hedgehogs as safe as possible by cleaning up their environment! Contact our team about hiring equipment.



**Don't use slug pellets.** Try to use a natural deterrent instead. Slug pellets are poisonous to hedgehogs and other wildlife!



**Fundraise for the British Hedgehog Preservation Society (BHPS).** Founded in 1982, the charity is dedicated to helping & protecting hedgehogs; as well as supporting the Hedgehog Friendly Campus campaign.



**Avoid feeding them milk.** Hedgehogs are lactose intolerant. A shallow dish of water, and one of meaty dog or cat food or cat biscuits is a better alternative for them.
